we would hire someone to pick up the limbs and place them in a truck and he would haul them away. Pat moved

that we pay someone \$10.00 an hour to help Walt, 2nd by Al.. Motion carried.

Al moved that since this was a working meeting that the board pay for our lunch, Vivian 2nd the motion, motion carried.

Walt moved that the meeting be adjourned, 2nd by Vivian, motion carried and Al closed the meeting.
